

Hale not only target of investigation by FBI

A federal investigation of white supremacist Matthew Hale was part of a broader investigation of other members of his racist group, prosecutors revealed in a filing this week in federal court.

The government also said it had turned over to Hale's lawyers hundreds of conversations secretly tape-recorded by an FBI informant who became Hale's security chief.

Hale is scheduled to go to trial next month on charges he solicited the murder of U.S. District Judge Joan Humphrey Lefkowitz in anger over her enforcement of an injunction in a civil lawsuit.
