

Jury selected for Hale's trial

A jury of eight men and four women, as well as four alternates, has been selected to hear the murder-solicitation trial of white supremacist Matthew Hale .

Opening statements by both sides are scheduled for Monday.

Hale, the self-proclaimed "Pontifex Maximus" of the Creativity Movement, has denied soliciting the murder of a federal judge in Chicago who ordered Hale's group to stop calling itself the World Church of the Creator.

After the selection process concluded Friday, half the jurors were minorities, who said they could be fair despite Hale's racist beliefs.
